METROPOL PALACE HOTEL

A landmark of Belgrade, this striking hotel designed by famous Serbian architect Dragiša Brašovan and originally opened in 1957 is regarded to be one of the most luxurious hotels in the Balkans, welcoming throughout its existence the city's elite and cultural influencers, as well as foreign guests. At today's Metropol Palace, we are committed to preserving the hotel's unique traditions and providing the latest in comfort for our guests.

The hotel's historical heritage effortlessly combines its elegance with the freshness of modern details, resulting in a refined and relaxed atmosphere. This has always been the trademark of Metropol Palace and the reason for the hotel's famous clientele, ranging from Igor Stravinsky, Elizabeth Taylor and Sophia Loren to Jack Nicholson, Neil Armstrong and Bobby Fischer.

The Metropol Palace is located in the old part of Belgrade on kralja Aleksandra Boulevard, one of the longest streets of the city.

Near to the hotel are the Tašmajdan Park, the National Parliament, the St. Marko Church. Within walking distance from the hotel are the shopping and pedestrian district (Knez Mihailova Street), the old Kalemegdan Fortress and Park, and Skadarlija - Belgrade's old-style bohemian area.

Airport Nikola Tesla is only 19 km (12.5 miles) away and the nearest highway exit is 1.5 km (1 mile) far.

LOCATION MAP



ACTIVITIES & ATTRACTIONS IN BELGRADE

We invite you to explore and enjoy Belgrade to the fullest. We have compiled a list of the very best that Belgrade has to offer to maximize your pleasure.

PARKS & GARDENS

TAŠMAJDAN PARK

Location: Between streets Beogradska, Bulevar kralja Aleksandra and Takovska street.

Tašmajdan Park is one of the largest and most beautiful parks in the city overlooking the Metropol Palace. Park was built in 1950s, but before that, it was a stone pit. Tašmajdan got its name from the combination of Turkish words: "Taš" (meaning "stone") and "Majdan" (meaning "pit"). After a recent renovation, Tašmajdan Park offers all modern standard facilities that can be expected.

KALEMEGDAN PARK & FORTRESS

Location: Between streets Tadeuša Košćuška, Cara Dušana and Bulevar vojvode Bojovića.

The Kalemegdan Fortress is located on a 125-metre-high cliff, at the junction of the River Sava and the Danube within Kalemegdan Park. Its name is formed from the two Turkish words: "Kale" (meaning "fortress") and "Megdan" (meaning "battle field"). It saw many armies, was the field of many battles, it witnessed the brutality of the conquerors and the courage of the tireless defenders of the city. Breathtaking sunset views over the Fortress are particularly special.

HYDE PARK, TOPČIDER AND KOŠUTNJAK

Topčider Park is positioned besides Košutnjak park-forest that was once home to deer and fawn (košuta) hunters. Two most elite suburbs (Dedinje & Senjak) are located in near vicinity with magnificent villas, residents to international diplomats, celebrities and politicians. Located only 5 km from the city centre, this oasis holds a special place in the hearts of many Belgrade citizens because of its cultural and historical significance marked by monuments and fountains. Interestingly enough, the oldest and most beautiful platanus tree was planted on Prince Miloš Obrenović's order besides his Residence in Topčider called "Milošev Konak". It is the oldest Planetree in Europe, protected as a natural treasure, over 170 years old.

Located in the city centre in Dorćol, Botanical Garden Jevremovac is a true green paradise. Founded in 1874. Jevremovac Botanical Garden lies across an area of around five hectares, has more than 250 types of trees and about 750 types of herbaceous plants, local, European and exotic.

Situated at the very center of the city, the Belgrade Zoo, or the Good Hope Garden, holds on one of the most attractive city locations, an area of the Kalemegdan Park. It was founded in 1936 and it is one of the oldest homes of animal kingdom in Europe. It covers an area of 7 hectares and has more than 2,000 animals. The complex includes cafes and a souvenir shop.

MUSEUMS

One of the great Serbian writers, Momo Kapor once said: "Belgrade is a low-budget New York." The rich history of Belgrade and Serbia is very accessible to the public, through museums, music festivals, traditional restaurants and much more. Entrance fees to the majority of the cultural treasures are mini- mal or sometimes even free. To the guests of Metropol Palace, entrance fees may be different. Please, consult the reception for details.

NIKOLA TESLA MUSEUM

Nikola Tesla made significant contributions to the development of electric engineering, pioneering alternative current, radio and AC motors. Half of this small museum is dedicated to Tesla's personal artifacts, while the other half contains models of his inventions. Nikola Tesla Museum is a unique institution of science and culture in Serbia and in the world. It is the only museum in the world, which preserves the original and personal inheritance of Nikola Tesla. Location of the Nikola Tesla museum is a short walk from the Metropol Palace hotel.

The last few decades, the rich exhibiting and publishing activity as well as the diverse programmes for the public with new technologies in a prominent place, confirmed that the National Museum is an important center of communication and source of knowledge, an open, dynamic and accessible museum.

Pavle Paja Jovanovic is the most famous Serbian painter of Academic Realism. Some of his greatest work includes: Serbian Migrations, Crowning of Stefan Dušan, Takovo Uprising, Cockfighting, Decorating of the Bride, and Fencing. He also painted many famous portraits. His works can be found in European museums across the continent. Location of the Paja Jovnović museum is a short walk from the Metropol Palace hotel.

Princess Ljubica's Residence in Belgrade was built between 1829 and 1831. The residence was for Miloš Obrenović's wife Ljubica and their children. It is preserved as the most representative city house from the first half of the 19th century. Architecturally, it contains Ottoman attributes but with elements of classicism which anticipate future Western influences on architecture in Belgrade.

Permanent exhibit includes original furniture made in Ottoman Balkan style and many other styles of that time (Classicism, Biedermeier and Neo-baroque).

THEATERS

OPERA

Located in the city centre, The Belgrade Philharmonic Orchestra and Kolarac are the oases of classical music where both the most famous local and foreign artists perform. Belgrade's National Theatre is also the National Opera and Ballet, located in the main city square only a 15 minute walk away from the hotel.

There is another Opera House in Belgrade - The Madlenianum Theatre in Zemun, an old part of the city, on the other side of the river.

MUST SEE

SKADARLIJA STREET

The old, cobble stone, bohemian quarter of Belgrade, Skadarlija, was once a gathering place for many Serbian poets, writers, artists and actors. It is frequently compared to the Montmartre of Paris, both in appearance and dynamic artistic atmosphere.

Contemporary Skadarlija is a "must see" tourist attraction with famous traditional restaurants, art galleries and antique shops. The sound of trumpet players and traditional "kafanske" songs will leave you speechless and full of emotion. If you want to order a song and stand out from the crowd, we suggest "Djelem, Djelem" originally sang by Šaban Bajramović (the greatest Serbian gypsy singer). This is a cult gypsy song that was improvised by many famous international singers.

KNEZ MIHAILOVA STREET

Knez Mihailova is the main pedestrian street in Belgrade located between Terazije Square and Kalemegdan. Crowded with cafes and boutiques, the street never sleeps. As an epicenter of culture and history, it was named one of the most beautiful pedestrian streets in Eastern Europe.

Among leading shops and cafes, the street is home to the French Cultural Centre, National Theatre, National Museum, Republic Square and other historic buildings.

Once you reach Kalemegdan Park from Knez Mihailova, turn left to Pariska Street, going past the French embassy. Again, turn left to Pop Lukina Street towards Residence of princess Ljubica, which will lead you to one of the most beautiful suburbs in Belgrade called Kosančićev venac.

DORĆOL CITY QUARTER

Dorćol is a Turkish word meaning "four roads." As one of the oldest suburbs, Dorćol was known as the Danube Town, where during the times of Ottoman, beside Turkish merchants and craftsmen, lived Jewish, Greek, Armenian and Serbian merchants. Today, Dorćol is the Manhattan of Belgrade, known for its galleries, cafes, restaurants, nightclubs and live music venues. The most famous street in Dorćol is called Strahinjića Bana.

BETON HALL & BRANKO 'S BRIDGE

One of the main Belgrade Ports is also home to popular nightspots, festivals and tourist attractions. It is located on the Sava bank, under the Branko's bridge in Karađorđeva Street, with stunning views of the Kalemegradan fortress. It is a gateway through which you enter Belgrade. There is an elevator which you can take to Branko's bridge (particularly convenient for the cyclists) and continue your journey over the bridge by foot or bicycle to the suburb of NewBelgrade and Ušće shopping centre or choose the opposite direction straight to the main Terazije Square and Knez Mihailova.

MUST SEE

VRAČAR CITY QUARTER

Vračar is one of the most beautiful residential areas of Belgrade, located less than a kilometer away from the city centre and across the street from the hotel. Vračar is home to St. Sava church, The Kalenić Open Air Fresh Market, The National Library and Karađorđev Park. Walk around, discovering little streets that lead to great bakeries, cafes, wine bars and traditional restaurants, as well as a variety of international restaurants, overlooking one of the small squares or parks.

THE DANUBE AND SAVA RIVER

The Danube is 2850 km long and one of the greatest rivers of the world. It passes through Serbia and represents a link to Germany, Austria, Hungary, Croatia, Romania and Bulgaria.

The Sava River is 945 km long and passes through Serbia, connecting Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Experience Sava and the Danube rivers up close by taking a walk or a bicycle ride along the shore. Stop for a drink and have lunch at one of many floating restaurants, or experience the city from all angles by taking a cruise on one of the boats.

New Belgrade bank of the Sava river is very popular with authentic "splav" (river raft) nightclubs. This is the place where people come during hot summer nights.

ZEMUN

The Danube bank leads to a very popular promenade called Kej oslobođenja in Zemun. Zemun has been a municipality of Belgrade since 1945. The promenade is particularly beautiful during night-time, with well-known restaurants serving delicacies of local seafood dishes as well as other traditional Serbian meals.

While in Zemun, we recommended you visit Gardoš, the highest point of Zemun. According to legends it is remembered as a settlement of fishermen, craftsmen and fruit and vegetable vendors.

NEBOJŠA TOWER

Nebojša's tower is located along Sava bank port besides Bulevard vojvode Bojovića (formerly known as Karađorđeva Street) that is approximately 2 km long. The main entrance is from this street, however you can also enter the pedestrian area at the sports centre "Milan - Gale Muškatirović" in Tadeuša Košćuška Street and walk alongside the river to reach the tower.

Nebojša's tower was built in 1460 for the purpose of defending the city from the Otoman Empire. It is the only remaining well preserved medieval building within the Belgrade Fortress.

Among many restaurants, cafes and river rafts, the Sava bank is home to sports centre "Milan - Gale Muškatirovic" (once called "25th of May") and summer festivals, such as: fish festival and the boat carnival held every year during June and July.

ORTHODOX CHURCHES

ST. MARK'S CHURCH

St. Mark's Church at Tašmajdan was built in the 1931-1940 period at the place where the old church from 1835 used to be. Architects Petar and Branko Krstić designed it in Serbian-Byzantine style.

ST. SAVA CHURCH

The Cathedral of Saint Sava or Saint Sava Temple in Vračar, Belgrade, the largest Orthodox church in the Balkans and one of the 10 largest church buildings in the world. The church is dedicated to Saint Sava, founder of the Serbian Orthodox Church and an important figure in medieval Serbia. It is built on the Vračar plateau, on the location where it is believed his remains were burned in 1595.

CHURCH OF CHRIST THE KING

Located in one of the most beautiful streets, very close to Metropol Palace, Christ the King is the oldest Catholic Church in Belgrade. Its construction was undertaken in 1924.

MOSQUE

BAIRAKLI MOSQUE

Belgrade once had more than 80 mosques. Today, Bajrakli Mosque, built in 1575, is the last one remaining. As the number of mosques in Belgrade decreased, a flag on top of this one marked the beginning of prayer in all remaining mosques. After that flag mosque got its name "Bayrak" (meaning "Turkish"). During Austrian rule in the first half of 17th century, Bajrakli Mosque was converted into Catholic Church and most of other mosques were destroyed. After Turks regain its rule, church was reconverted into mosque. Today stands as the only place of prayer for Muslims in Belgrade.

SYNAGOGUE

SYNAGOGUE

This is the only synagogue remaining in Belgrade. Building of today's Jewish synagogue was built as a confirmation of Serbian–Jewish friendship. Document confirming this friendship was signed and immured in the foundations by King Aleksandar. There are regular services on Friday evenings and Jewish holidays.

Avala stands at 511 meters above sea level, which means it enters the mountain category just by 11 meters. Rich in natural, as well as historical and cultural heritage, located 16 km from Belgrade, is ideal for maintaining physical fitness. Approximately ten kilometers of marked hiking paths are ideal for walks and recreation.

The Avala tower is the main tourist attraction offering great panoramic views of Belgrade, Vojvodina and Šumadija. The tower was once the tallest structure in former Yugoslavia and the Balkans.

SPORTS

Serbia is a sporting nation where teams and individuals have proudly represented their country, gaining world recognition by becoming world number one in the following disciplines: football, basketball, water polo, volleyball, handball, athletics, and tennis. Red Star football club is the only Serbian and former Yugoslav club that has won a UEFA competition, winning the 1991 European Cup in Bari, Italy.

The national basketball team won a number of back-to-back European Championships and World Cups. They dominated the world scene in 1990s led by players such as: Vlade Divac, Peđa Stojaković, Aleksandar Đorđević and Dejan Bodiroga. The following individuals have left their mark in the world of Serbian sport: Novak Djoković, Vlade Divac, Dragutin Topić, Jasna Sekarić, Nemanja Vidić, Olivera Jevtić and Milorad Čavić, to name a few.

The magnificent sports building, one of the biggest in the Balkans, is a witness of many decades of success and triumphs of Red Star. The official name of the stadium is Rajko Mitić, but most people simply call it Marakana. The biggest success of the club happened in Belgrade, at the Marakana Stadium in 1991 when the Golden generation of the Serbian club won European and World Championships.

Partizan stadium resides at the spot, which was always in a midst of most important football events in the country. Soon after "The Great War", and with utter respect for sports tradition, works on a new football ground started on exactly the same spot, as was the case with the Red Star stadium. The first post-war match on newly built stadium took place on the 9th of October 1949, and rivals were Yugoslavia and France, drawing 1:1 in a World Cup Qualifier tie.

Due to strict FIFA criteria over the past few years, especially in a domain of spectators comfort and security, in 1998 spectators' terraces have been reconstructed, seats and modern equipment installed, therefore, the present capacity has been reduced to 32.710 seats.

DOOR VIEWER

It is recommended that you identify individuals through the viewer on the entrance door before opening the door. In addition use of the secondary locking device will give you additional security.

(DIAL 0 for security) In the event of an emergency, please contact the Operator.

OTHER EMERGENCIES

FIRE IN HOTELS

In case of fire it is important not to panic trying to leave the hotel rooms as soon as possible. You need to pay attention to the following necessary instructions.

a) Emergency exits

When you are accommodated in the hotel room, you should do the following:

- 1. Make sure that all doors and windows are in good condition and report any irregularities (defects) to the reception desk.
- 2. Note the number of the fire service and put it close to the phone.
- 3. Go out into the hallway and see where the nearest fire escape is.

b) The dangers of smoke

Smoke and toxic gases form during fire. Remember that smoke rises to the ceiling where it becomes thickest - so do not straighten up, high concentration of smoke can cause blindness, dizziness, fainting and even death due to suffocation from poisonous gases.

Smoke can enter your hotel room through the vent-hole, the spaces around the front door or through an open window. Also, the smoke may be coming from a smoldering fire in the bed mattress – in fact, 75% of hotel fires in the world are caused by the inattention of smokers.

SAFETY & SECURITY

c) Evacuation

- 1. In case of fire, leave the room immediately as follows:
- 2. Take your documents and keys and go to the front door of the room (if necessary, crawl to avoid inhalation of smoke).
- 3. Touch the front door with your hands, including the door handle, to determine whether you feel any heat. If the door is hot, DO NOT OPEN IT because it means that the fire is in the hallway.
- 4. If you do not feel the heat, open the door slightly, with your hand on it to be able to close it quickly if the hallway is filled with smoke. If the hallway is not filled with smoke, leave the room closing the door behind you.
- 5. Go to the nearest fire escape, walking along the wall on the side where the fire exit is located, so you do not miss the exit in case of poor visibility due to smoke.
- 6. When you get to the fire escape, climb down the stairs, holding the railing tightly.

NOTE:

- If smoke fills the fire escape on the lower floors, go back and go to the roof (the fire escape is designed to lead from the ground floor to the roof).
- When you reach the roof, leave the fire escape's door open, so that the smoke from the fire escape can be cleared.
- Find the upwind side of the building sites there and wait to be evacuated by the members of the fire brigade.

d) If you are trapped in your room

If the front door of your room is warm to touch or if the hallway is filled with smoke, it is safer to stay in the room and wait for the help of firefighters.

Until help arrives, you should do the following:

- 1. If the outside air is clean, open the window (do not break the glass, so you do not hurt yourself).
- 2. Call the front desk to let them know that you are trapped in the room.
- 3. Turn on the ventilation in the bathroom, if exists, if not leave the bathroom door open and fill the bathtub with water.
- 4. Soak the sheets, blankets and towels in the bath and put them under the front door and around the door frames to prevent smoke entering the room.
- 5. If the front door becomes very hot when you touch them, use ice bucket, vase or larger glass and use them to take water from the tub and spill on the door. You can also soak the mattress from the bed, stand it up against the door and prop it up with commode or some other piece of furniture, so it doesn't fall, and soak it with water from the bathtub, keeping it constantly wet to protect the door from the fire, until the fire brigade arrives.

DO NOT FORGET THAT PANIC IS THE GREATEST ENEMY IN SITUATIONS OF FIRE AND WE APPEAL TO YOU TO DO AS STATED IN THESE INSTRUCTIONS AND CALMYWAIT FOR THE HELP OF THE FIRE BRIGADE
